Omar Barghouti - Palestinian researcher, commentator and human rights activist and a leader of the Palestinian Campaign for Boycott, Divestment & Sanctions (BDS)

George Mahlangu - Campaigns Officer, COSATU (Confederation of South African Trade Unions)
